Pine: Length - 5'0" to 5'3" and in multiples: diameter - Min. 3½"DIB @ small end - Max. 20" DIB @ large end

Pulpwood

Hardwood: Length - varies with company usually 4' - 6' and longwood; diameter min. 5" DIB @ small end - Max. 28" DIB @ large end (no cedar, dogwood, locust)

Pulpwood

I. Pines:

Shortwood - 46" sticks, maximum DIB @ large end - 20", minimum DIB @ small end = 3"

Longwood - Logs 12' - 45', diameter limitations same as above

II. Hardwoods:

Lengths from 10' up, maximum DIB @ large end = 25", minimum DIB @ small end = 5" (no pine, cedar, cypress)

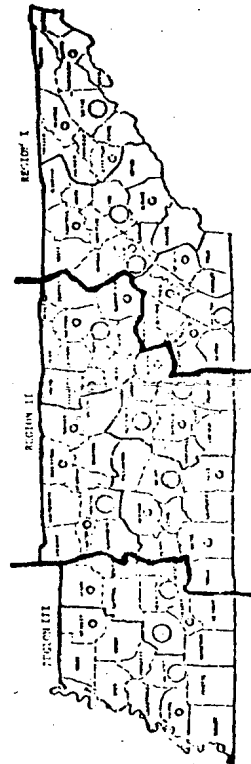
