Pulpwood

Pine: Length 5'0" to 5'3" and in multiples. Dia. - min. 3½" DIB @ small end. Max 20"

\$38.00/cord (5350 lbs/cord)

Add approximately \$1.00/cord for each additional 20 miles from mill.

Pulpwood

Hardwood: Length varies with company, usually 4'-6' and longwood. Dia. - min. 5" DIB @ small end. Max. 28" DIB @ large end (no cedar, dogwood, locust)

\$12.54/ton

Add approximately \$1.00/ton for each additional 20 miles from mill.
